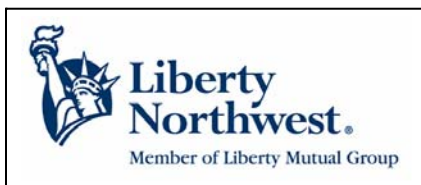
APPLICATIONS
