What is WorkSafe Champions?

WorkSafe Champions is an education program offered at no charge to our policyholders. Over the course of ten modules, participants will learn about workers' compensation, how to motivate and train employees, manage an incident, more effectively return an injured employee to work and much more. Join the many Montana employers who have benefited from Montana State Fund's WorkSafe Champions program!

How does it work?

One of our qualified Safety Management Consultants will administer ten modules (roughly 20 - 24 hours of instruction) at your location. You set the pace and schedule. We require at least three dedicated participants (more are welcome and encouraged) committed to the entirety of the program, one of which must be in a position to influence safety within your organization. Class enrollment is open year round. As our resources are limited, please let us know quickly if you are interested.
